## About UO Portland

- Fully transitioned to new campus in NE Portland in Fall 2024
- New amenities include student housing, a gym, an athletic field, and student hub (Campus Center); funding is needed to program, maintain, and staff these spaces
- UO Portland students do not currently pay a Recreation Fee or a Student Union Fee

Rec Fee—related facilities:







### Recreation Fee:

- •Hiring/training student employees—customer service, ensuring user safety, facilitating programs
- •Fund programming—non-credit fitness classes, student rec leagues, special events
- •Maintenance of fields—routine upkeep, repairs, enhancements
- •Purchase and maintenance of gym equipment—incl. sports gear and fitness equipment
- Offset some operational costs (e.g. utilities, facility upkeep)

### Student Union Fee—related facilities:







### Student Union Fee:

- •Orientation initiatives (5 fall, 2 winter/spring/summer)--supplies, marketing, printing, etc.
- •Student life initiatives—supplies, speakers, events/workshops
- •Student basic needs—food bank, support for housing/transportation/childcare/ health services
- •Hiring/training student employees—customer service, campus tours, ensuring we have allies who are prepared for emergencies
- •Offset costs for Campus Center information hub—mail room, welcome center, events
